It can be purely descriptive, or an explanation of why this place means so much to you, or a combination of description and the feelings evoked by this special area.

Each entry should only include the author's name and WI and year date. By sending in the entry, each author accepts that the piece of writing may be published as an anthology or collection of entries from more than one year which may be non-winners and winning entries. This work is by members of SFWI and will carry the SFWI logo. The SFWI reserve the right to select the entries for publication and assume rights of Intellectual Property for publication. All authors who have their work published in this way will be informed in good time before publication, will assume to have agreed, and may not withdraw their work once published.
